TOUR de SUNNYSLOPE



Sunnyslope is part of the Desert Horizon Police Precinct, home to the **only bicycle squad in Phoenix**—and one of the city's top-performing squads for crime prevention and enforcement.

Once a year, we proudly partner with this squad for **Tour de Sunnyslope**, a four-mile, family-friendly bike ride through the neighborhood. This event is designed to show neighbors of all ages that **police are people too**, creating a remarkable opportunity for positive police-community engagement.

The ride features about **12 police officers on bicycles**, accompanied by police vehicles with flashing lights to ensure everyone's safety. Over the past two years, Tour de Sunnyslope has continued to grow, with families coming from across the Valley not only to ride alongside officers but also to **build real relationships with them**.

The ride begins at **8:30 a.m. at Slope Fest**—a tradition that has quickly become a community favorite!

The East Sunnyslope Community has built strong, ongoing partnerships with city officials, law enforcement, and community agencies to better serve our neighborhood. These collaborations have led to lasting improvements in safety, livability, and community connection.

- **District 3 – Debra Stark**

Current Councilmember and past Vice Mayor. She has partnered with us on multiple initiatives, including neighborhood clean-ups and the Gated Alley Pilot Program, which provided secure alley gates and significantly reduced crime.

- **District 6 – Kevin Robinson**

Current Councilmember, retired Police Commander, and former Assistant Chief. His extensive law enforcement background brings valuable insight into neighborhood safety initiatives.

- **Kate Brophy McGee**

Current Maricopa County Supervisor, former Arizona State Senator, and past school board member. She has supported neighborhood projects that strengthen families and improve access to resources.

- **Phoenix Police Department**

We work closely with multiple divisions, including the city's only Bicycle Squad, which leads our annual *Tour de Sunnyslope*. Our Community Action Officers also provide year-round support addressing quality-of-life issues and building positive police-resident relationships.

This department has assisted in organizing community events and supporting residents in need, particularly those who face financial or physical challenges in maintaining their homes.


- **Mayor Kate Gallego** – A huge supporter of our efforts.



DIVERSITY IN SUNNYSLOPE

Did you know that the Sunnyslope neighborhood has more Native American and Russian ancestry people living in it than any neighborhood in America? It is true! In fact, 3.7% of this neighborhood's residents have Native American ancestry and 3.0% have Russian ancestry.

Sunnyslope is also pretty special linguistically. Significantly, 1.0% of its residents five years old and above primarily speak Native American languages at home. While this may seem like a small percentage, it is higher than 97.5% of the neighborhoods in America. (NeighborhoodScout)
